Form W-4 (2004)

Purpose. Complete Form W-4 sid that your employer can withhold the cornect Federal income tax from your pay. Because your tax situation may change, you may want to refigure your withholding each year.

Exemption from withholding. If you are exempt, complete only lines 1, 2, 3, 4, and 7 and sign the form to validate it. Your exemption for 2004 expires February 16, 2005. See Pub. 505, Tax withholding and Estimated Tax.

Note: You cannot claim examption from withholding if: (a) your income exceeds \$800 and archides more than \$250 of unearned income (e.g., increst and dividends) and (b) another person can claim you as a dependent on their tax return.

Basic instructions, if you are not exempt, com-pine the Personal Allowances Worksheet below The worksheets on page 2 adjust your withholding allowances based on itemazed.

deductions, certain credits, edjustments to income, or two-earner/two-job situations. Complete all worksheets that apply, However, you may claim fewer (or zero) allowances. Head of household, Generally, you may ctaim head of household filling status on your tax return only if you are unmarried and pay more than 50% of the casts of keeping up a home for yourself and your dependent(s) or other qualitying individuals. See line E below. Tax credits, You can taxe projected tax credits into account in figuring your allowable number of

Tax credits. You can taxe projected tax credits into account in figuring your allowable number of withholding allowances. Credits for child or dependent care expenses and the child tax credit may be claimed using the Personal Allowances. Worksheet below. See Pub. 319, How Do I Adjust My Tax Withholding? for information on converting your other credits into withholding allowances.

Nonwage income, If you have a large amount of nonwage income, such as interest or dividends, consider making estimated tax payments using

Form 1040-ES, Estimated Tax for Individuals. Otherwise, you may owe additional tax.

Two earners/two jobs. If you have a working spouse or more than one job, figure the total number of ellowances you are entitled to claim on all jobs using worksheets from only one Form W. 4. Your withholding usually will be most accurate when all electromore. rate when all allowances are claimed on the Form W-4 for the highest paying job and zero allowances are claimed on the others.

Nonresident alien. If you are a nonresident alien, see the Instructions for Form 8233 before completing this Form W-4

Check your withholding. After your Form W-4 takes effect, use Pub, 919 to see how the dolar amount you are having withheld compares to your projected total tax for 2004. See Pub, 919 especially if your earnings exceed \$125,000 (Single) or \$175,000 (Married).
